Project “Strategic Partnership for Creativity and Entrepreneurship (acronym SP4CE)” has been funded with support from the European Commission under the ERASMUS+ Programme. Project started on 1 September 2015 and will end on 31 August 2017.

Project activities and events

Multiplier events

Six Multiplier events were carried out by project partners during the final period of the project realization to disseminate the project results to target audience and to gather feedback from event participants regarding project outcomes. Total 180 participants took part in these events. In Poland 75 participants took part in 3 events organized in Gdańsk by PRO-MED, in Slovakia 49 participants took part in event organized in Kosice by ASTRA, in Hungary 34 participants took part in event organized in Nagykovacs by TREBAG and finally 22 participants took part in event organized in Piraeus by IDEC.

During these events partners presented project results the audience in order to inform them on the project and gather feedback. Multiplier events were connected with workshops where event participants were able to actively use SP4CE platform. The reception of the presented results was very positive and after the event we were able to launch pilot cooperation with companies interested in the functionalities that offers the solution developed.

Final Working Meeting in Gdańsk

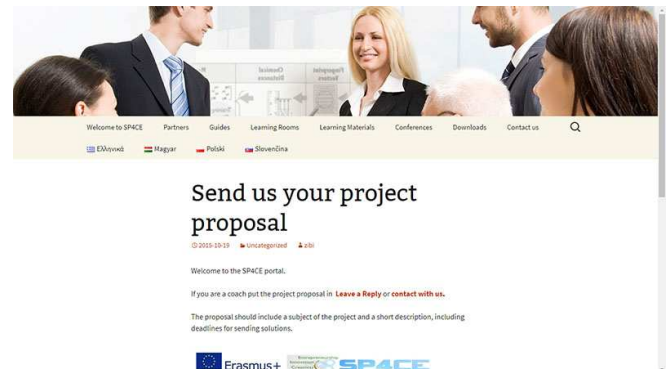
